Coach Hagiya recently returned from playing in Spain after playing the prior two seasons in Greece. Starting at point guard, she led the team in scoring, assists, and steals. Prior to her professional career, Coach Hagiya played collegiate basketball for USC, where she was a two-time captain and posted the top assist/turnover ratio in the Pac-10 as a junior. At USC, she is 4th all time in career assists and 2nd all time in career 3 pointers. She led her team to two NCAA appearances, each year making it to the second round. As a prep standout at South High in Torrance, she won three consecutive Ocean League championships and was named three times the Ocean League MVP.

Coach Kristin has just finished her 3rd season as an Assistant Coach at CalPoly. She works with the guards and more specifically the point guards. She helped our starting point guard lead the nation in assist/to ratio in 11- 12. Kristin had an outstanding playing career at Cal from 01-05. She was a four year starter and four year team captain. As the starting point guard she lead the nation in Free Throw percentage in 2005. She was a All Pac- 10 award winner as well as holds single season records for single season Free Throw % and 3pt Shooting %. She prepped at Archbishop Mitty High School in San Jose, CA and was the standout point guard on the undefeated 1999 team that won a Division 1 state title. She played for the CYS Organization, SJ Ninjas and SJ Zebraettes.
